- Must be certified through IKO or PASA
- Must have current first aid/cpr certification
- Must have prior teaching experience using jet ski watercraft or be willing to put in at least 15hrs of unpaid training time. If under age 50, must have Oregon Boater's Card.
- Excellent communication skills and positive attitude
- Super responsible and able to work without supervision

## Job Description:

Teach youth and adults to kiteboard with the utmost attention to guest service, safety, and communication in order to provide a fun and memorable experience. Book lessons and earn a 5% commission, be willing to put in time in retail shop as needed (mostly no wind days)

## Teaching Hours:

Minimum 2 per day, Maximum 6. Wind dependent schedule, you will have the opportunity to put in some time in the retail shop on no wind days. Lessons start at 10:00am or when the wind comes up.

## Pay:
